Session Objectives/ Descriptions:

This session is to report the current situation and results of the project, "community, social entrepreneurship and local economy activation," funded by Foundation Research Project of the National Research Foundation of Korea. Three paper will be presented. The first presentation is about social capital and social innovation in South Korea. The primary goal of the research is to test the relationship between social capital and social innovation in local communities. Based on three dimensions of social capital including trust, norms, and networks, the study explores how each dimension of social capital affects social innovation. The second presentation is about the effect of volunteer work on participation in social economy organizations. They used a survey data of 1,900 community residents in areas where the social economy organizations are considered to be active. The interview results on community activists were also used for discussion and policy implications. The last presentation will be also empirical analysis on social entrepreneurship in Korea. By analyzing the antecedents of social entrepreneurship in South Korea, the importance of learning and education for community development has been emphasized.

- **Moo-Kwon Chung** is currently the director of Institute for Poverty Alleviation and International Development (IPAID) in Yonsei University and a professor of the Department of Global Public Administration at Yonsei University, Wonju, South Korea. He received his Ph.D. in political science, Indiana University, USA. His areas of expertise are the welfare state, social policy, comparative political economy and development, social economy and public administration. He served as a president of Korean Association of Social Policy (2011-2012) and Korean Society of Public Administration Theory (2013-2014). He was the organizer of the 3rd International Conference on Social Enterprise in Asia (July 4-6, 2014, Wonju, Korea). He is currently a member of the education and research group on BK21 FOUR on Local Community Innovation and New Public Governance in an Era of Global Crisis by the Ministry of Education. He has written widely articles and book chapters on the Korean welfare state, East Asian welfare regime, the public sector and organizations, social enterprise, and development.

- **Sang-Il Han** is a professor of global public administration at Yonsei University. Professor Han is interested in social economy, nonprofit organizations, neighborhood participation, and international administration. His research examines the relationship between learning organizations and the publicness of public and nonprofit institutions, and the effects of neighborhood organizations' and citizens' participation in public settings. During 2007-2008, he served on the editorial boards of International Review of Public Administration and Journal of Regional Development and Studies and the member of operating committee at the Korean Association for Public Administration.

- **Minjeong Park** is a Ph.D. student in the department of Public Administration at Yonsei University. She is interested in social innovation, social economy, institutional theory, and local governance.



- **Joohee Park** is a research fellow of Institute for Poverty Alleviation and International Development (IPAID) at Yonsei University. Her research interest is social economy, cooperatives and community organizing.
